Relationships Reset is a Citizens UK project involving academy trusts across the country. It seeks to challenge sexual harassment in areas such as the transport system. BDAT students have been at the forefront of the project over the past couple of years. They have met people of power, including the Mayor of West Yorkshire, Tracy Brabin, to enlist their support in challenging sexual harassment. Students from BDAT have collaborated with others across a range of trusts to co-create a website designed for teachers to signpost high-quality resources to support the effective delivery of topics such as consent.

One of the main successes of the Relationships Reset project has been the drafting of a Student Charter for Action. BDAT students were heavily involved in the writing of this document. The Charter has been signed by the CEOs of academy trusts, including TKAT, The Education Alliance, Fairfax Multi-Academy Trust, Summit Learning Trust and BDAT itself. The Charter commits the trusts to 'providing safe and inclusive learning environments for our students' and 'to address and prevent sexual harassment within our schools'. The CEOs recognise that 'by fostering a culture of respect, awareness and accountability, we strive to ensure that every student feels safe, valued and empowered to reach their full potential'.
